Kath Wissinger

Kath Wissinger is well-known for her clear directing style and her connection with the ringers. She encourages ringers to embody the music they are performing, whether sacred or secular. Technique drills and theory lessons are woven into rehearsals to demystify the score and improve overall performance.



Kath has over 60 compositions in print, covering all levels, ranges and styles.

Kath has directed teen and youth ensembles in her church for over 20 years – currently outreach ensemble *AdventuRing*. She teaches handbell classes in a private school, and directs the community ensemble *MOSAIC*. She has directed festivals and taught classes across the country, as well as in Japan and Canada. Kath also teaches piano in her home studio in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia.
